## Why?

By 2030, net international immigration will account for ~84% of total annual increase in Ontario's population

Colleges are responsive and serve communities; immigrants are a significant and growing segment of these communities



## What?

System Change – intent of CIITE, to enhance existing and build new processes to serve internationally trained immigrants in the college system

Sustainability – ultimate goal of project



## What?

### Project activities:

Advising

Credential Recognition (*My Record*)

Marketing & Communications

Evaluation

Technology systems – to support project activities (Colleges Advisement System, *My Record*)

## Who?

ITI – Internationally Trained Immigrant, an individual who has been in Canada for 0 to 5 years and whose education/training was obtained outside of Canada (as defined by MTCU)

MTCU– Ministry of Training Colleges and Universities, the funder of Phase 3.2 (2009-2011)

MCI – Ministry of Citizenship and Immigration, funder of previous phases, including Phase 3.1 (2008-2009)

## Who?

Ontario colleges – all are involved in the delivery of CIITE

### Key Project Partners:

- OCAS – Ontario College Application Service
- WES – World Education Services
- ICAS – International Credential Assessment Service



## Who?

Steering Committee – governing and decision making body

Working Groups – advise on project direction, report to Steering Committee

Project Team – responsible for project implementation

CON\*NECT Strategic Alliances – contract holder, accountable for project



## When?

2003 – CIITE implemented (Centennial, George Brown, CON\*NECT)

August 13, 2009 – funding for Phase 3.2 started

March 31, 2011 – funding for Phase 3.2 will end



## Where?

CIITE services are provided by the colleges throughout the province
